



Report on Awareness Programme on Menstrual Hygiene and Well-Being

Introduction

Menstrual health and hygiene constitute important facets of women's health and well-being affecting their health, education, employment, dignity, productivity and overall quality of life.

However due to stigma, lack of knowledge, poor practices, socio-cultural barriers and

limited access to sanitary products, many women and adolescent girls face challenges in

managing their menstrual health effectively. To addressthesecritical issuesofmenstrual health

an awareness programme on Menstrual Hygiene and Well-being was conducted with an aim

to enhanceparticipants' capacity to equip and empower themselves with basic information

and resources about menstruation and its proper hygienic management. This programme was

particularly focused on resolving misconceptions about menstruation, improving health

outcomes and promoting gender equality.

**Objectives** 

The main objectives of the programme were:

1) To provide complete education about menstrual health and hygiene.

2) To bust myths andtaboos associated with menstruation.

3) To promote practices that enhance menstrual health and overall wellbeing.

4) To create a supportive environment to discuss menstrual health issues.

# Topics covered included

- Biological aspects of menstruation
- Importance of menstrual hygiene
- Different types of menstrual products, their proper usage and disposal methods.
- Safe and hygienic practices.
- Psychological and emotional aspects of menstruation
- Nutritional guidance to support menstrual health

# **Question and Answer Session**

The participants were given an opportunity to ask questions and discuss their concerns in a supportive manner. Both the students and faculty eagerly engaged in a dialogue with the guest by asking him questions on various issuesof menstrual health and hygiene such as ecofriendly menstrual practices, urinary tract infections, polycystic ovarian syndrome etc.Personalized advice and guidance were provided by the guestfor each of the questions asked by the participants.

## Outcome

After attending the programme, participants felt an increase in their knowledge about menstrual health and hygiene. They reported a better understanding of the biological processes, hygiene practices, and ways to manage menstruation related symptoms and problems.

#### Feedback

Post-programme feedback from the participants revealed the session to be educational and usefulmaking it an engaging and insightful learning experience for all.
