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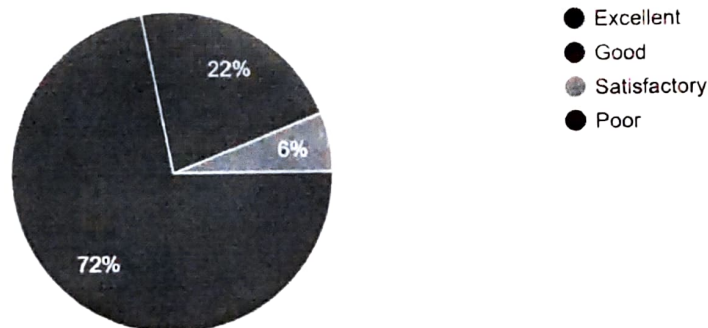

Below shown charts reflect the feedback obtained from students through the structured questionnaire.

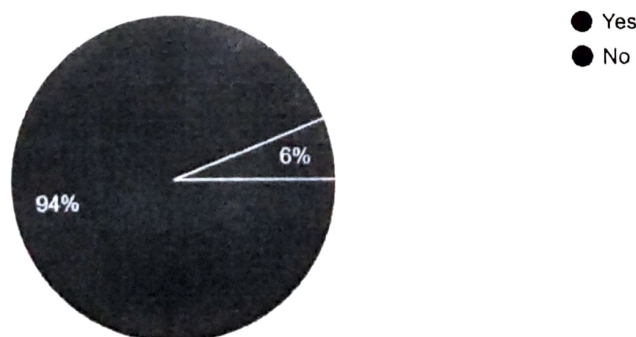
How would rate this educational tour?

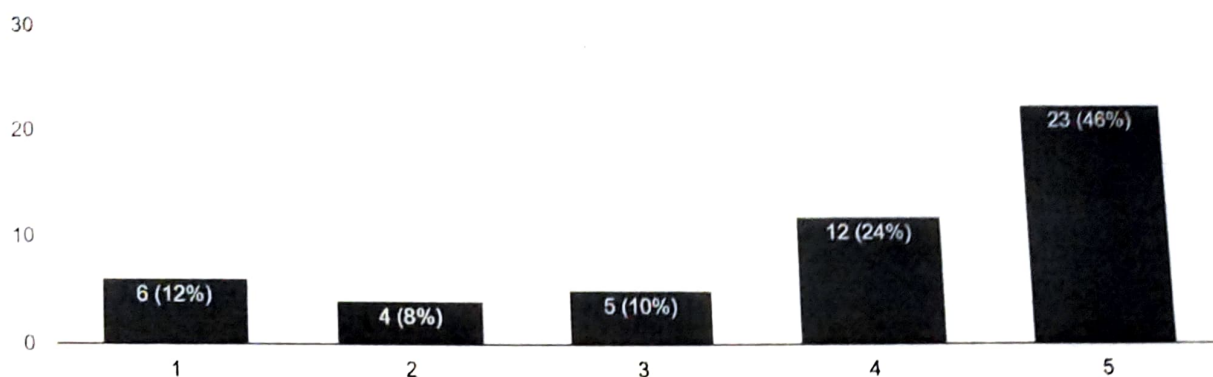
Was this trip well organised?

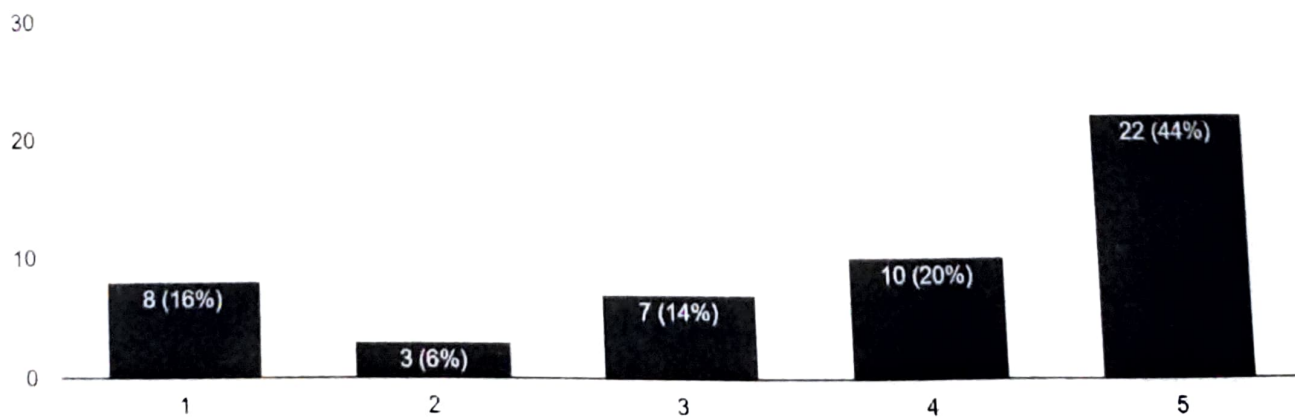

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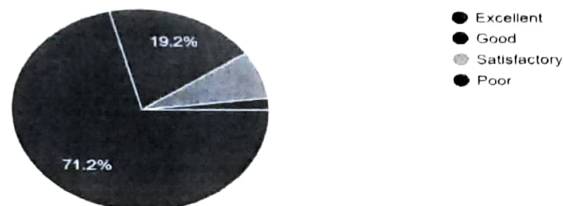

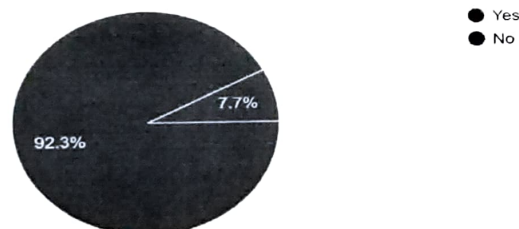
How would you rate this field trip?

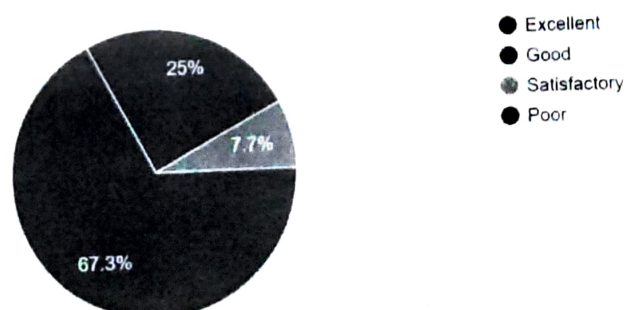

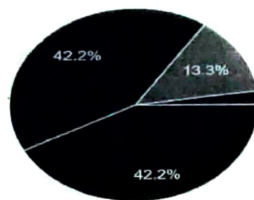

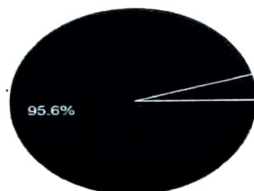

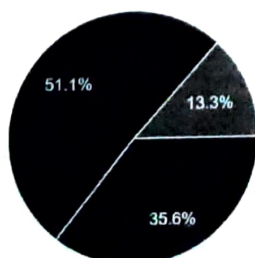
